"We do have one bedroom for disabled people. We have access to our bar with a ramp for wheelchairs, also for the Hugos private dining rooms. The access to our meeting rooms is also no problem for people who are using a wheelchair."

"We have 4 handicapped friendly rooms (not 100 % handicapped accessible). There are lower light switches, an emergency switch and wider doors."

There is a disabled-friendly toilet on the ground floor.

The hotel is accessible without stairs and lifts leading to all floors.

Accessibility

At Crowne Plaza Berlin City Centre Ku'damm, we are committed to ensuring that our facilities are accessible to all guests, including those with disabilities. Our hotel is equipped with several features designed to provide comfort and convenience for guests with mobility, visual, or auditory impairments:

- Accessible Guest Rooms: We offer wheelchair-accessible rooms with features such as widened doorways, roll-in showers, grab bars in the bathrooms, and lowered fixtures for ease of use.
- Public Areas and Facilities: All public areas of our hotel, including the entrance, restaurants, lounges, and business center, are wheelchair accessible. We have elevators serving all floors, and service animals are welcomed throughout the hotel.


We have two rooms in the house that are disabled friendly, so that guests with wheelchairs can easily stay overnight in these rooms.







The InterContinental hotel which is our main location for the event will accommodate most of our delegates/companies for their stay during the event.

Along with the InterContinental we are working with 4 other partners hotels being:

- > The Palace hotel: 7 min walk from the InterContinental (500m)
- Crowne Plaza: 8 min walk from the InterContinental (550m)
- > Berlin Berlin: 9 min walk from InterContinental (650m)


